

**UBC SCHOOL OF KINESIOLOGY CO-OP PHOTO CONTEST
OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES**

1. CONTEST

1.1. The University of British Columbia (“**UBC**”) is a contest sponsor of UBC School of Kinesiology Co-op Photo Contest.

1.2. This contest will be run from January 1, 2016 to December 16, 2016, 11:59 PM Pacific Time (the “**Contest Period**”).

2. HOW TO ENTER

2.1. No purchase necessary. Only one entry per person. For clarity, one entry may include a maximum of 5 photographs. This contest is open to all students registered in the UBC School of Kinesiology Co-Op Program, who are Canadian residents, and the age of majority in their province of residence, excluding Quebec residents (“**Entrants**”). Employees and faculty members of UBC are not eligible to enter this contest.

2.2. Entrants may enter the contest by submitting a photograph that meets the criteria to UBC School of Kinesiology via [NTD: insert info for WORDPRESS Site] with the Subject Line “CO-OP Photo Contest” by the closing date and time posted for the Contest Period. The winning Entrants will be judged on the following criteria:

- a. How well the photograph represents the UBC School of Kinesiology Co-Op Program;
- b. How well the photograph depicts the Entrant’s experience in the UBC School of Kinesiology Co-Op Program;
- c. How creative the photograph is; and
- d. Use of technical composition (i.e., color, framing and symmetry).

2.3. The Entrant and any other individuals depicted in the photograph must expressly agree to the use of their images by UBC for the purposes of marketing, recruitment or public relations involving the Program, such as UBC websites, printed and electronic newsletters, brochures, and promotional items (the “**Purpose**”). All photographs submitted for this contest become the property of the UBC, whether selected as a winning entry or not. By entering the contest, the Entrant acknowledges and agrees:

- a. She or he has obtained all prior consent of those individuals in the photograph to have their image taken and submitted for this contest, and such individual(s) understand that their image may be used for the Purpose;
- b. The photographs in the entry do not:
 - i. contain any third party trade-marks, name or logos;
 - ii. include any nudity, lewd or obscene behaviour; or

iii. infringe the intellectual property or privacy of a third party.

3. HOW TO WIN

3.1. Entrants' photos will be judged by a selection of committee members that may include staff, faculty, students, and external employers involved in the UBC School of Kinesiology Co-Op Program. The committee will select the winners on in January 2017 based on the criteria set forth in Section 2.2 above. The odds of winning depend on the number of Entrants.

4. PRIZES

4.1. The prizes are as follows:

- a. 1st place: \$50 Gift card to the UBC Book Store;
- b. 2nd place: \$25 Gift card to UBC Food Services; and
- c. 3rd place: \$10 Gift card to Starbucks™.

4.2. The prizes must be accepted as awarded. No substitutions of the prizes are permitted except by UBC at its discretion. UBC reserves the right to substitute any of the prizes with other prizes of equal or greater value if any prize cannot be awarded as described for any reason. Prizes are non-transferable and are not redeemable for cash or credit, in whole or in part.

4.3. UBC may require winners to sign a liability/publicity release, including a consent to UBC posting the winner's name and photograph on its website. If a winner fails to return the contest documents within the time specified by UBC, s/he will forfeit their prize and an alternate winner will be selected.

5. GENERAL RULES

5.1. By participating in this contest, each entrant and winner agrees to: (a) be bound by these Official Contest Rules and the decisions of UBC; and (b) release and hold harmless UBC, and its Boards of Governors, officers, employees and agents from and against any and all liabilities, losses, claims, demands, costs and expenses (including lawyer's fees and litigation expenses on a solicitor and own client basis) whatsoever to which any of them may become subject arising from any actions or omissions by the entrant.

5.2. By participating in this contest, each entrant and winner agrees that UBC may post the winner's name and photographs on its website.

5.3. All photographs submitted for this contest become the property of the UBC, whether selected as a winning entry or not.

5.4. The UBC Kinesiology Co-operative Education Program may require a Consent to Use of Image Form to be submitted by all the Entrants. Failure to comply will result in the selection of an alternative winner.

5.5. The decisions of UBC in relation to this contest will be final and binding on all entrants.

5.6. UBC reserves the right to cancel, terminate, or suspend this contest, at its discretion, at any time without prior notice.

5.7. Each Prize claim is subject to verification by UBC and/or its designated representatives. Entries made with multiple addresses, under multiple identities, or through the use of any device or other method to enter multiple times or entries that are in excess of the permitted number of entries are automatically void. All contest entries obtained through unauthorized sources or which are incomplete or in any way not in compliance with these Official Contest Rules are automatically void. UBC is not responsible for lost or late entries. UBC is not responsible for any miscommunications, failed communications systems, software malfunctions, or for any human errors in connection with this contest. UBC may suspend or terminate this contest if UBC is of the view this contest's administration or fair play has been compromised.

5.8. Your personal information is collected under the authority of Section 26(c) of the *Freedom of Information and Privacy Act* (FIPPA). This information provided to enter this contest will be used only to administer this contest, and for no other reason.
