**BKIN MINOR IN COMMERCE PROGRAM – INFORMATION SHEET**

- Enrolment in this program is strictly limited to 25 students and an application is necessary. Application forms will be available from April 15 to May 15 only and can be picked up from the KIN Advising Office during office hours or found on the KIN website. Completed applications must be submitted no later than 3:00pm on May 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Who is eligible?
  - Applicants must be completing an undergraduate degree in the School of Kinesiology.
  - Students wanting a foundation in business management are encouraged to consider the “Minor in Commerce.” Enrolment in this program is limited to students eligible for third-year standing, with a cumulative average of at least 68% in the previous two years.
  - Admission to the program requires completion of:
    - ECON 101 (3)       ECON 102 (3)
    - one of MATH 100 (3), 102 (3), 104 (3), 120 (3), 180 (4) or 184 (4)
- Upon successful completion of the Minor program, the notation “Minor in Commerce” will be added to the student’s transcript.
- The program will consist of:
  - COMM 329 (3)       COMM 457 (3)       COMM 465 (3)       COMM 473 (3)
  - COMM 493 (3)       one of COMM 398 (3) or COMM 458 (3)
- Applicants will be informed by e-mail in mid-June if they have been selected for the minor program, been placed on a waiting list, or have not qualified for either the minor program or the waiting list.
- Before you apply, ensure that your 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year program requirements do not conflict with the Minor.
- Note that the credits required for admission to the program and the upper-level 18 credits required for the Minor **must be percentage-graded**, and **cannot be taken as Credit/D/Fail**.
- Upon successful completion of the Minor program, the notation of “Minor in Commerce” will be added to the student’s transcript.
- **Application deadline is May 15<sup>th</sup> by 3:00pm to the Kinesiology Advising Office.**
