BKIN MINOR IN SCIENCE PROGRAM – APPLICATION FORM

- An acceptable program must comprise courses recognized in the Faculty of Science that are for credit towards a Bachelor of Science degree and consist of at least 18 upper-level credits (300/400-level) in a single subject field or specialization, together with any prerequisites. Students should design a coherent and academically sound course of studies for their proposed minor, which must be approved by the Kinesiology Advising Office at the beginning of third year. **All courses must be acceptable for a Science Major in the proposed subject area or field.**
 - In addition, the following courses can be used for credit towards a Minor in Biology: CAPS 301, CAPS 390, CAPS 391, FNH 350, FNH 351, FNH 450, and FNH 451.
 - Note that the 18 credits **must be percentage-graded**, and **cannot be taken as Credit/D/Fail**.
 - Students who wish to pursue a Minor in Science should be aware of the prerequisites of many of the upper-level courses in Science.
 - Students who wish to pursue studies in the Faculty of Education should be aware that courses which are acceptable for a Minor in Science may not necessarily meet the requirements for a teaching concentration in the Faculty of Education.
 - Upon successful completion of the Minor program, the notation of “Minor in Science” will be added to the student’s transcript.
