Parent / Participant Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct is to promote a safe and healthy environment for all participants. It identifies standards of behavior that are expected of all participants and their family members. The Code of Conduct applies to all UBC School of Kinesiology Outreach Programs activities and events. The following conduct is expected of all participants and their family members:

- I will show respect and understanding for the rights of fellow participants and their family and conduct myself in a way that reflects the principals and goals of UBC.
- I will show respect for participants and their families regardless of gender, ethnic or racial origin, sexual orientation, age, marital status, religion, political belief, disability or economic status.
- I will inform the coach of any injury or illness before the start of the lesson.
- I agree to play by the rules established by instructors and will refrain from intentionally harming other participants physically, psychologically or emotionally.
- I agree to refrain from public criticism, including but not limited to any written or electronic discussions/chat rooms/blogs etc. about the Active Kids Program, UBC employees, program participants or their families.
- Parents, spectators and visitors will not coach or give instructions to participants during class.
- Parents will respect the wishes of their child and not force them to participate in an activity.
- I will ensure that my child wears appropriate attire while participating in activities: long hair tied back, no belts, proper athletic footwear, all jewelry removed.
- I will respect the schedule of the program and be on time for classes. Parents will pick their children up promptly at the end of class.
- I will not engage in aggressive or inappropriate behavior of any kind
- I will bring concerns about the conduct of other children, parents, and staff to the attention of a supervisor or manager.

Conduct, at all times, shall reflect honesty, good sportsmanship, courtesy and respect toward others. All participants are encouraged to co-operate for the betterment of sport. Unsportsmanlike conduct is not acceptable and is subject to disciplinary action. **Anyone found in violation of the code of conduct may be removed from a program.**
