NOTES

- ① Students planning to apply to professional programs are strongly encouraged to determine the necessary undergraduate requirements that are available in other faculties such as Science and Arts.
- ② Students in the Kinesiology Interdisciplinary Studies stream must complete a minimum of 18 credits of non-KIN electives, of which at least 12 credits must be at the 300/400-level.
- ③ All students must complete a minimum of 30 credits of KIN (percentage-graded) at the 300/400-level.
- ④ All students must complete a minimum of 48 credits in total (percentage-graded) at the 300/400-level
- ⑤ Students *must* come in to KIN Advising in-person for an appointment before selecting the CREDIT/D/FAIL option for a course.
- ⑥ Students who have completed *both* KIN 190 and KIN 191 *cannot* take KIN 131 for credit towards their degree (considered as 'extra'). Students who have completed *one* or *neither* of these courses must come in for an appointment with KIN Advising.
