- Students are expected to follow all requirements for BKIN as noted under [Degree Requirements](#) and [Stream Requirements](#).
- Courses can be taken in any order and any combination, but note that you are expected to pay careful attention to prerequisites for second-year (200-level) and upper-level (300/400-level) courses. For KIN courses, it is best to complete all first-year (100-level) core KIN courses before progressing to the next level, and so on. See suggested course sequence [here](#).
- Students **must** receive written approval from KIN Advising before selecting the **Credit/D/Fail** option for a course. Key requirements (e.g., WRDS 150B, all core KIN, and upper-level requirements – see “4” below) **cannot** be taken as Credit/D/Fail.
- All students must complete at least 48 credits at the 300/400-level (including at least 36 credits of KIN at the 300/400-level) for **percentage-grade** (**not** Credit/D/Fail). Noted above as “UL” (upper-level; 300/400-level).
- *21 of the 36 credits of UL KIN must be **stream-specific**. * For a list of eligible courses for each stream, see details [here](#).
