

# Study Title : Examining Various Administration methods for UNICEF'S Early Childhood Development Index 2030 Assessment

## Why is this study being done?

UNICEF created a measurement tool to determine children's level of development for comparison across countries.

This research aims to test the reliability and accuracy of this tool when administered in a variety of ways (in-person interview, paper-based/online questionnaire, phone interview and zoom interview).



**Are you eligible?** We are seeking parents of 3.0-4.9 year old children, who are the primary caregiver of the child. You should be able to communicate (speak and read) in English

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### What are you required to do?

- Provide Informed Consent
- Complete Child Development assessment 3 times.

2 interview assessments  
(1 in-person and 1 on  
phone/zoom)

1 self-directed  
questionnaire.

- Complete 5 minute assessment 3 times. Including providing information about child's development (count, jump ability)
- Complete 5-minute questionnaire about you and your child (e.g., child's age, your education level).
- Participation will require a total of 20 minutes over a 2-week period
- Participants can receive up to \$20 as an incentive.
